



TEXTBOOKS

Our textbooks all have a classmark on their spine (a subject number and three letters of the author's name), which you can also find on the catalogue. They are organised in ascending order numerically, in Bays II-V.

NORTH LIBRARY

The North Library contains our collection of international serials, arranged alphabetically around the room. The Bay to the right of the door contains our Tax and Business materials. It is accessible only via the Gallery, through the double doors at the end. Our multi-faith room is in the back right corner.

GRIFFIN COLLECTION

The Griffin collection in Bay XXXIV is our lending collection, and all items can be borrowed for 2 weeks. This is primarily books about law, biographies and items relating to the history of the Inns of Court.

ACCESSIBLE BAY

Bay VII is a dedicated workspace for Library users with visual impairments. It contains a large monitor, with software installed for magnification, screen reading and editing the colours and contrast. It also contains a magnifier for print materials, where colours and contrast can also be altered as needed.
