Rules

- Open to student members of the Inn who are seeking pupillage, or any members of the Inn who have been called to the Bar for less than twelve months (as at the submission deadline) and are seeking pupillage
- Applicants may not have already gained a Michael Beloff Essay Prize
- This is an individual competition (no teams may enter)
- Your essay **must** be 3,000 to 5,000 words (including footnotes) - essays below or exceeding these lengths will **not** be considered
- The essay must be your original composition
- Your essay must be signed using a pseudonym
