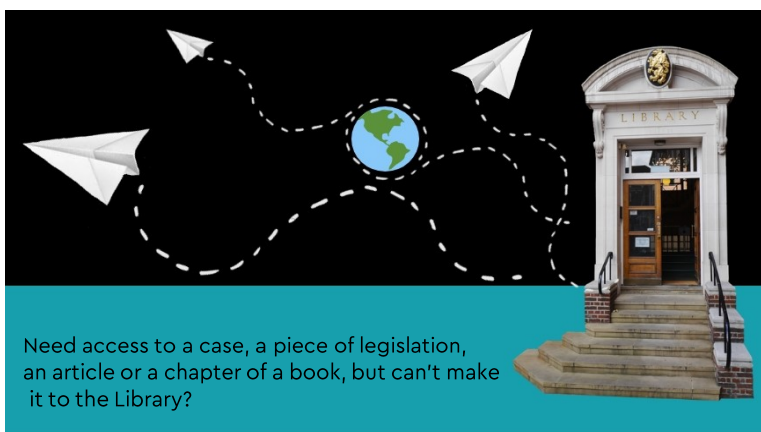
Opening Hours

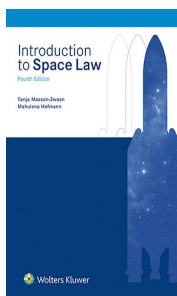

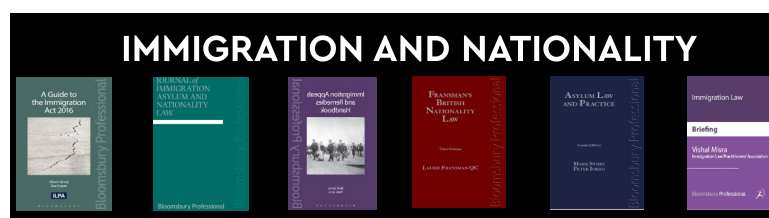

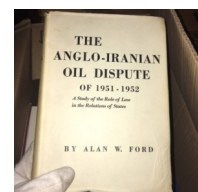
The service also provides full-text access to resources in 20 practice areas, including company and commercial, employment, environment, family, immigration, local government, property and personal injury.

Bequeathed to the Inn by the late Master Elihu Lauterpacht, the Collection is a significant acquisition for the Library and an important supplement to its flagship international law collection. Consisting of Master Lauterpacht's personal library, the Collection comprises books, journals, law reports, pamphlets, off-prints, government publications and conference proceedings relating to international law. Work is underway sorting and cataloguing the Collection in what will be a major project.
